- Indian Institute of Management Shillong, IIM S commenced its operations in the year 2008.
- The average domestic package offered to the candidates in 2020 was 18.76 LPA • The highest domestic package offered to a student in 2020 was 48.50 LPA • The average domestic package (top 20% offers) to the candidates in 2020 was 29.17 LPA and average domestic package (top 50% offers) to the candidates in 2020 was Rs. 23.38 LPA

Admission Process:

The admission process for the PGP program comprises two phases

Phase 1 – Shortlisting for PI- Step 1

For consideration in this shortlist, following are the minimum requirements

Table 1: Minimum Requirements* of Marks required for shortlisting in various categories

Shortlisting for PI- Step 2

The candidates obtained from the above filtering are then classified into 7 academic categories. The applicants are segregated based on their academic category AC 1 to AC 7

Applicants of each academic category will be shortlisted proportional to their representation in the overall number of applicants. For example, if 60% of the overall applicants belong to AC-4, then 60% of the shortlisted candidates would be belonging to that category. It is represented as follows :

Table 2: Academic disciplines Number and Percentage (α_i) of Candidates

Academic disciplines(i)	Number of Candidates present in Academic Disciplines (N_i)	Percentage of Candidates from each Academic Disciplines(α_i)
1	N_1	$\alpha_1 = \frac{N_1}{N} \times 100$
2	N_2	$\alpha_2 = \frac{N_2}{N} \times 100$
3	N_3	$\alpha_3 = \frac{N_3}{N} \times 100$

g	N_g	$\alpha_g = \frac{N_g}{N} \times 100$
Total	N	100

Within each academic category, the percentage of calls given to the candidates is as follows:

- No. of calls to the ST category candidates = 7.5% of total calls
- No. of calls to the SC category candidates = 15.0% of total calls
- No. of calls to the Other category candidates = 67.5% of total calls
- No. of calls to the EWS category candidates = 10% of total calls
- No. of calls to the DA category candidates = 5.0% of total calls

The required number of candidates from each academic category and reservation category is as follows:

Phase 2 – Final Merit Listing for Admission Offer

Final Merit Score = 70% (Normalized PI Score) + 30% (Normalized overall CAT score)

Candidates will need to ensure that they meet the minimum cutoff performance in the PI round in order to land a final admission. The cutoff in terms of a percentage of minimum performance in PI to the maximum possible score in the round is different across reservation categories. Following is the corresponding table -

Categories	Cut-off as Minimum Percentage of Performance out of Maximum Possible Performance in PI
DA	20.0%
ST	20.0%
SC	25.0%
OTHERS (OT)	30.0%
