## The different types of **MBA** programs are:

### 1. **Two-year Full Time Program**

The most common and sought-after MBA program of most of the Indian B-schools (some exceptions being ISB-Hyderabad and Great Lakes-Chennai which are renowned for their one-year programs).

### 2. **One-year Executive Program**

These programs are targeted at working professionals with at least two-to-three years of work experience; and are looking for further growth in their career. IIM-Ahmedabad's PGPX, IIM-Bangalore's EPGP, and ISB-Hyderabad's PGP are the most prestigious one-year executive programs in the country.

### 3. **Part-time and Working Manager's Program**

In addition to these, there are MBA programs available for Working Executives (Part-time programs/ Weekend programs). For instance, the Working Manager's Programme (WMP) from IIM Lucknow is available to students, who cannot take a break of one or two years.

### 4. **Postgraduate Diploma in Business Analytics (PGDBA)**

Ranked among the top 10 programs across the world just 2 years after its inception, the prestigious PGDBA (offered jointly by IIM Calcutta, IIT Kharagpur and ISI Kolkata) is a must for anyone interested in the emerging field of data analytics.

### Eligibility Criteria for most of the Management Entrance Written tests

- Minimum 50% - Bachelor's Degree or Equivalent in any stream.
- Minimum 45% for SC/ST/DA candidates.

### Selection process

The selection process of B-schools mostly consists of two steps:

#### Step I (Aptitude Test)

Almost every B-school conducts (or uses) a Written Test, which is typically an aptitude test. There are a number of MBA entrance exams to get into your coveted management institute. However, for the most sought-after B-schools, the IIMs, CAT (Common Admission Test) is the written test for selection.

#### Step II (GD/PI/WAT)

The shortlisted candidates from the written test round are called for a Group Discussion, Personal Interview, and Written Ability Test (Essay) round. While most of the IIMs conduct only the PI and WAT, many other B-schools include GDs, along with the PI and WAT rounds.

### What is a Percentile?

The CAT percentile is referred to as the total percentage of candidates who scored less than or equal to a particular candidate. For example, if a candidate's CAT percentile is 99, it means his/her performance was better than 99 percent of the total CAT test-takers that year.

Remember:

- It is not a percentage.
- It is not an average value.
- It is not equal to the total marks.

## Admission Criteria of B-schools

While the selection process is only of two steps, the actual admission criteria involves the following six parameters:

- **Written Score** - A weightage of around 30 percent.
- **Academic Scores in X, XII, and Graduation**- An average weightage of 10 percent each. Total 30 %.
- **Work Experience** - A weightage of around 5 percent.
- **Academic Diversity** (for some B-schools)- A weightage of around 5 percent.
- **Gender Diversity** (for some B-schools)- A weightage of around 5 percent.
- **Extracurricular/Co-curricular activities** (S P Jain and others)- A weightage of around 5 percent.
- **Interview/ WAT** - A weightage of around 20 percent
