



IIM KOZHIKODE MBA Admission 2022-2024

Recent Changes

Same as the admission criteria for the batch 2021-2023. No such changes for IIM Kozhikode PGP 2022-2024 Admission.

The admission process for the PGP program comprises following stages.

- 1. Online Registration of candidates who meet the minimum eligibility criteria for PI call.
- 2. Shortlisting candidates for PI round.
- 3. Final Selection of candidates based on overall merit scores.

STAGE- 1: For getting IIM Kozhikode call for the PI- WAT round, a candidate must satisfy the below given minimum CAT 2021 percentile and 10th and 12th scores criteria:

During the first stage, initially, a pool of candidates who satisfy the following minimum CAT 2021 percentiles and SSC/HSC percentages are considered.

* The percentage of marks obtained in Class X and Class XII would be calculated based on the aggregate marks of all subjects that appear in the marks sheet or grade sheet, irrespective of whether the Board considers them for calculation of percentage.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- The candidates who fulfil the above mentioned shortlisting criteria will receive an email for Online Registration for admission to IIM Kozhikode's PGP 2022-2024 program.
- The shortlisted candidates will be required to Fill-in and submit the Online Registration Form within the stipulated time frame specified by IIM Kozhikode. The shortlisted candidates who fail to submit their form before the deadline will not be allowed for Stage- 2 (PI process).
- Online registration is a Pre-Interview Registration Process and is not a final call for the PI round.

STAGE-2: Shortlisting of candidates for PI round on the basis of Online Registration Form

The following is the criteria used while shortlisting candidates for the PI round.

Parameter	Weightage
CAT 2021 Score	45%
10 th /SSC score	25%
12 th /HSC score	15%
Gender/Academic Diversity	10%
Work Experience	5%

The details of each component are given as follows:

1) CAT Index Score:

Scaled scores from the three sections (with equal weightages) of CAT 2021 will be considered for the computation of the CAT Index Score. The CAT Index Score will carry a weight of 45%.

2) SSC/Class X/IB/Equivalent Percentage Score:

The percentage of marks obtained in SSC/Class X/IB/Equivalent would be calculated based on the aggregate marks of all subjects that appear in the marks sheet or grade sheet, irrespective of whether the Board considers them for calculation of percentage. The SSC/Class X/IB/Equivalent percentage scores are first adjusted by dividing each score by the highest percentage score obtained in the Board and then that adjusted score is multiplied by 25. The database of SSC/Class X/IB/Equivalent percentage scores of all CAT applicants for the past three years including the current year is used for identifying the highest percentage score of a Board.

3) HSC/Class XII/IB/Equivalent/Diploma Percentage Score:

The percentage of marks obtained in HSC/Class XII/IB/Equivalent/Diploma would be calculated based on the aggregate marks of all subjects that appear in the marks sheet or grade sheet, irrespective of whether the Board considers them for calculation of percentage. The HSC/Class XII/IB/Equivalent/Diploma percentage scores are first adjusted by dividing each score by the highest percentage score obtained in the stream of that Board and then that adjusted score is multiplied by 15. The database of HSC/Class XII/IB/Equivalent/Diploma





percentage scores of all CAT applicants for the past three years including the current year is used for identifying the highest percentage score of a stream in a Board.

4) Gender/Academic Diversity Score:

Marks are awarded for gender/academic diversity. Only female candidates are eligible for a gender diversity score. A candidate with (or pursuing) a bachelor's degree or equivalent in a discipline other than engineering/technology will be eligible for the academic diversity score. A candidate is entitled only to an applicable diversity score of 10, from either gender diversity or academic diversity and not both.

5) Work Experience Score:

a) Previous work/professional experience will carry a weight of up to 5%, depending on the length of service as on December 31, 2021.

Only fulltime remunerative work experience after graduation will be considered. Parttime/Project/Internship/Articleship/Pre-Graduation work experience will not be counted as work experience. A candidate with a work experience of 6 months or above will be eligible for work experience score. A sample illustration of the marks awarded is provided in the Annexure 1.

b) Reg. Self-employment/partnership experience: fulltime self-employment must be established using any two of the following documents:

i. Registered partnership deed,

ii. MCA/RoC firm registration certificate,

iii. GST registration of firm,

iv. Firm's audited statements of account (for at least two continuous financial years),

v. DIPP Certificate of Recognition.

At least one of these documents should indicate the name of the firm and the name of the candidate as promoter/director. The other document must refer to the firm's name or registration number. The later date in these two submitted documents will be taken as the start date of self-employment. The minimum duration of self-employment which is accepted for evaluation is 24 months. Both dates used to calculate start of self-employment must be after date of award of candidate's last educational qualification.

c) Candidates may opt for only one of the two tracks, i.e. either a) or b) above, even if they have a combination of work experience and self-employment.
